## ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL COMMITMENT PLAN

- The Republic of Türkiye (Borrower) will implement the Türkiye Earthquake Recovery and Reconstruction Project (Project), with the involvement of the İller Bankasi Anonim Şirketi (ILBANK), the Ministry of Health (MoH) and the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change (MoEUCC) (each an Implementing Agency and collectively, Implementing Agencies) as set out in the Loan Agreement. The International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (Bank) has agreed to provide financing (P180849) for the Project, as set out in the referred agreement.
- 2. The Borrower, through ILBANK, MOH and MOEUCC, shall ensure that the Project is carried out in accordance with the Environmental and Social Standards (ESSs) and this Environmental and Social Commitment Plan (ESCP), in a manner acceptable to the Bank. The ESCP is a part of the Loan Agreement. Unless otherwise defined in this ESCP, capitalized terms used in this ESCP have the meanings ascribed to them in the referred agreement
- 3. Without limitation to the foregoing, this ESCP sets out material measures and actions that the Borrower, through ILBANK, MoH and MoEUCC, shall carry out or cause to be carried out, including, as applicable, the timeframes of the actions and measures, institutional, staffing, training, monitoring and reporting arrangements, and grievance management. The ESCP also sets out the environmental and social (E&S) instruments that shall be adopted and implemented under the Project, all of which shall be subject to prior consultation and disclosure, consistent with the ESS, and in form and substance, and in a manner acceptable to the Bank. Once adopted, said environmental and social (E&S) instruments may be revised from time to time with prior written agreement by the Bank.
- 4. As agreed by the Bank and the Borrower, through ILBANK, MoH and MoEUCC, this ESCP will be revised from time to time if necessary, during Project implementation, to reflect adaptive management of Project changes and unforeseen circumstances or in response to Project performance. In such circumstances, the Borrower, through ILBANK, MoH and MoEUCC, and the Bank agree to update the ESCP to reflect these changes through an exchange of letters signed between the Bank and the Borrower, the Head of the International Relations Department of ILBANK, the Vice Minister of Health, and the Director General of Construction Affairs in MoEUCC, copied to Ministry of Treasury and Finance. The Borrower through ILBANK, MoH and MoEUCC shall promptly disclose the updated ESCP.
